Bibliography

The ensuing list of references includes all the works cited in *TAC Commentary* plus many others. The main scope of the subjects covered is the EA texts themselves, especially studies on individual letters and essays on the grammar, syntax and rhetoric of the dialects represented in the archive. Abbreviations are those of *CAD* and *AHw* as well as those used in the *Keilschriftbibliographie* published annually in *Orientalia*. Egyptological abbreviations generally follow the *Zeitschrift für ägyptische Sprache und Altertumskunde*.

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
